**Sponsorship for International Research Fellowship (Visiting Professor)**

To promote international collaboration and research ecosystem of Chiang Mai University, the sponsorship for International Research Fellowship at Chiang Mai University (Visiting Professor) is now open for applications.

**Qualifications of eligible applicants** are as follows (in accordance with Article 4 of Thai Version of Announcement):

1. affiliate to a higher education institution or research institute abroad,
2. must not be an employee of Chiang Mai University,
3. have a good research record internationally with consistent publication up to the present;
  - 3.1 publish at least FOUR articles in journals listed in Q1 or Q2 of ISI Web of Science (Core Collection) as the first author or the corresponding author in the last three years (*for applicants in the field of Science & Technology and Health Sciences*),
  - 3.2 publish at least THREE articles in journals listed in Q1 or Q2 of SCOPUS as the first author or the corresponding author in the last three years (*for applicants in the field of Social Sciences and Humanities*),
4. be well-acknowledged internationally in the field of application,
5. do not have any pending task or obligation with any funding agencies or educational institutions,
6. can work on-site at Chiang Mai University and/or cooperate with the Chiang Mai University Corresponding Person effectively on-line, and
7. do not have any previous negative research ethics records or show association with research ethics violations.

**Qualifications of Chiang Mai University Corresponding Person** are as follows (in accordance with Article 5 of Thai Version of Announcement):

1. be a full-time academic personnel of Chiang Mai University and not on any kind of long leaves (*e.g.* study leaves, sabbatical leaves, oversea research leaves),
2. have a good research record internationally with consistent publication up to the present;
  - 2.1 publish at least TWO articles in journals listed in Q1 or Q2 of ISI Web of Science (Core Collection) as the first author or the corresponding author in the last three years (*for applicants in the field of Science & Technology and Health Sciences*),
  - 2.2 publish at least ONE articles in journals listed in Q1 or Q2 of SCOPUS as the first author or the corresponding author in the last three years (*for applicants in the field of Social Sciences and Humanities*),
3. have tentative plan for teaching, research and co-publication with the nominated applicants,
4. do not have any pending task or obligation with Chiang Mai University,
5. do not have any previous research ethic issue or show association with research ethics violations, and
6. can be a group of no more than TWO academic personnel for the correspondence (of one candidate).

**Terms of sponsorship** are as follows (in accordance with Article 6 of Thai Version of Announcement).
